

My Gay Games Outreach Over the Past Year

I've been very busy this past year helping to spread the word about the Paris Gay Games. It started right after the AGA in Sydney when I visited Fiji. Since I had no Gay contacts there I relied on Grindr to find some Gay locals. For the first time ever I actually met someone through Grindr, an Indo-Fijian named Rahul. I learned all about the challenges of being Gay in a country with several traditional religions: Christianity, Muslim and Hindu. Rahul is a Hindu. It isn't easy but thanks to the United States State Department under Secretary Clinton our embassy in the capital Suva is a sanctuary. And Rahul learned a lot about the Gay Games. I would really like to pursue this contact as I don't believe the FGG has never had a lot of participation from Oceania outside of Australia and New Zealand.

Other Gay Games promotional highlights:

- Buenos Aires World Congress of LGBT+ Jews: Reached out to a local Gay soccer player recommended by FGG Board Member Martha Ehrenfeld and gave him a supply of Spanish language Gay Games brochures.
- Gav Games at IML (International Mr Leather) in Chicago
- Madrid World Pride with fellow Front Runners and at their human rights conference
- Palm Springs international Gay Square Dance Convention
- Provincetown bookshops, hotels, Internet cafes, restaurants and pizzerias. (Of which later in the season friends returned to replenish)
- Montreal's first ever Canada Pride: In Montreal I volunteered to staff a Gay Games table and march with the Gay Games contingent in the pride parade. I will say, we had a great reception from all those who saw us marching.
- Paris World Congress of LGBT+ Jews
- Oslo and Bergen Gay bar

So, in the end I did a whole bunch of fun Gay things in eight countries on four continents and also two cities in the United States. I tried to spread the good news about our amazing Gay Games. I hope I made a difference because the Gay Games sure have made a big difference in my life.
